- Have fun!
- Positively reinforce my player and show an interest in their football.
- Encourage my player to take part, attend regularly and be on time. (This is all part of being in a team)
- Encourage my player to 'play by the rules.'
- Always show respect to Officials and Coaches and encourage my player to do the same.
- Celebrate effort, good play and progress.
- When young players make mistakes, offer them support and encourage them to try again.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Ensure my player is properly dressed for the weather conditions.
- Ensure that proper footwear and shin pads are worn.
- Be respectful in the delivery of feedback or suggestions to the coach.
- Speak up if I am concerned about the welfare or safeguarding of any of the young players at the club. I can speak to any of the coaches or the club welfare officer.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code of Conduct, I may:

- Issued with a warning by the coach or asked to leave the game.
- · Required to meet with the club committee or welfare officer.
- Be asked not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed.
- Or ultimately required to leave the club with my young player.
